Observing training sessions:

All parents, family members, and friends are welcome to observe camp sessions. All sessions for the All-Skills Camp will be held in The Venue (the big structure which sits directly behind the new basketball arena.) The closest available parking garage is Garage F. Garage F is located directly behind The Venue. You can park there for free during the hours camp is in session. Resident & Commuter Check-In:

All arriving parents and players should come to parking lot **B9**. Click on this link to find the exact location of parking lot B9: <http://campusmap.ucf.edu/flash>. Entering the UCF campus from University Boulevard or Central Florida Boulevard, turn right onto Gemini Boulevard. Proceed on Gemini Boulevard until you see signs for parking garage B on your left hand side. Just past parking garage B is parking lot B9. Make a left into parking lot B9 and drive to the back of the lot where you will be met by a Central Florida Volleyball Camp staff member.

You can either drop off your child, or park in parking lot B9 and accompany your child to check in. UCF parking will graciously permit you to park temporarily to drop off and pick up your children for camp.

All check in's will be conducted at the Libra Community Center. The Libra Community Center is located due North-East from the B9 lot. Central Florida Volleyball Camp staff will direct campers to the right place for check in.

Commuter Campers:

Commuter pick-up and drop off for the rest of camp will be outside the Knightro's dining center. To find Knightro's from parking lot B9, continue on Gemini around campus until you get to East Plaza Drive. Make a right on East Plaza Drive and continue down the street. You will see Knightro's on your left hand side.

Note: Commuter campers will only be released to their parent or legal guardian. Parents must call Coach Erik at (407) 242-6603 to arrange to have their child picked up by someone other than themselves.

Check out:

Commuter parents, please pick your child up in front of Knightro's. Resident parents, you can meet your child back in parking lot B9 or meet them in the Libra Community Center. Room keys must be returned to the Libra Community Center at Check-out. There is a \$50 charge for lost keys and a \$20 charge for lost meal cards.

Camp Packing List: (DO NOT BRING ANY VALUABLES)

- Enough volleyball clothing all sessions (make sure to bring extra of everything)
- Twin Sheets, blanket (or sleeping bag), pillow (pillow case)
- Small Athletic Bag to carry gear and personal items
- Bath Towels and Toiletries
- Rain Jacket or Umbrella
- Refillable Water Bottle (water is provided)
- **Bathing Suit/Sunscreen – We will be doing a training session at the Beach courts this year**
- Alarm Clock
- You won't need money for basic meals, but you may want to bring some spending money. We will have a camp store with snacks and apparel. Also many athletes like to order pizza back in the dorms at night.
- There will be no alcohol, no drugs, or tobacco products allowed on campus. Violation of this policy will result in the immediate expulsion of the athlete and a flight home.
- Behavior standards for this camp are extremely high. Athletes are expected to demonstrate respect for coaches, each other, service people (e.g., dining staff), etc.

From Orlando International Airport

Go east on 528 to 417 north. Take 417 North to University Blvd. Exit east onto University Blvd. Continue east on University Blvd. for approximately two miles and it will take you to the main entrance to the campus. Make a right turn at the first light, Gemini Blvd.

From Orlando Sanford Airport

Take Lake Mary Blvd. to 417 South. Take 417 South to the University Blvd. exit. Exit east onto University Blvd. Continue east on University Blvd. for approximately two miles and it will take you to the main entrance to the campus. Make a right turn at the first light, Gemini Blvd.

From Gainesville

Take 75 South to the Florida Turnpike South to 408 East. Take 408 East to 417 North. Exit off of 417 to University Blvd. East. Take University Blvd. 2 miles and it will take you to the main entrance of the campus. Make a right turn at the first light, Gemini Blvd.

From Jacksonville

Take I-95 South. Exit at Colonial SR50 West. Take SR 50 to Alafaya Trail (434). Make a right turn on Alafaya Trail. Continue on Alafaya Trail to University Blvd. Make a right turn at corner of University Blvd. and Alafaya. You are on campus. Make a right turn at the first light, Gemini Blvd.

From The South

Take the Florida Turnpike north and take 528 East. Take 417 North. Exit off of 417 onto University Blvd. East. Continue on University Blvd. for 2 miles and it will take you to the main entrance of the campus. (or)

Take I-95 North. Exit at Colonial SR50 West. Make a right turn on Alafaya Trail. Continue for approximately 2 miles to University Blvd. Make a right turn at corner of University Blvd and Alafaya. Right on Gemini Blvd.

From The East, Titusville and Daytona

Take Highway 50 West to Alafaya Trail. Turn right on Alafaya Trail, go north for two miles. Turn right onto University Blvd. and you are on campus. Make a right turn at the first light, Gemini Blvd. (or)

Take I-4 West to 417 South. Exit off of 417 at University Blvd. East. Continue on University Blvd. East and it will bring you straight into campus. Make a right turn at the first light, Gemini Blvd

From The Tampa Area

Take I-4 East to 408 East. Take 417 North and exit off of 417 at University Blvd. East. Continue on University Blvd and it will take you to the main entrance of the campus. Make a right turn at the first light, Gemini Blvd
